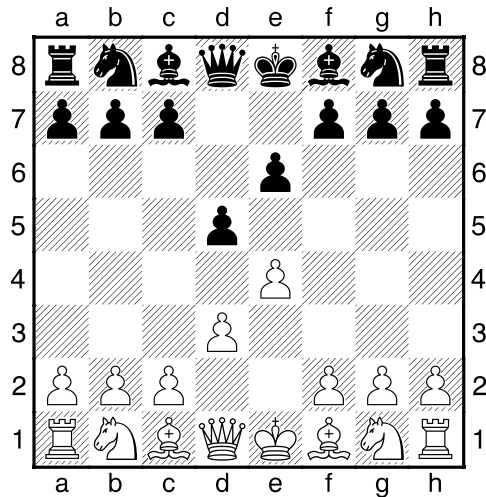

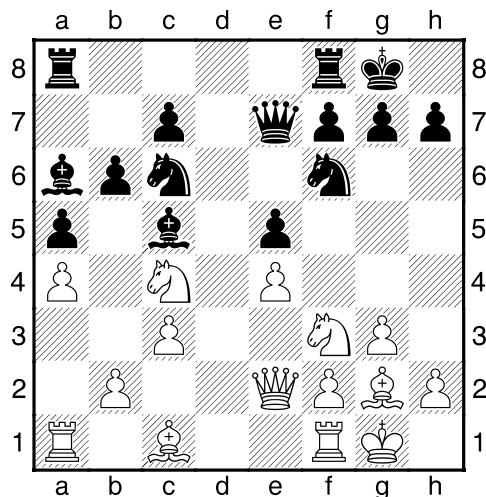

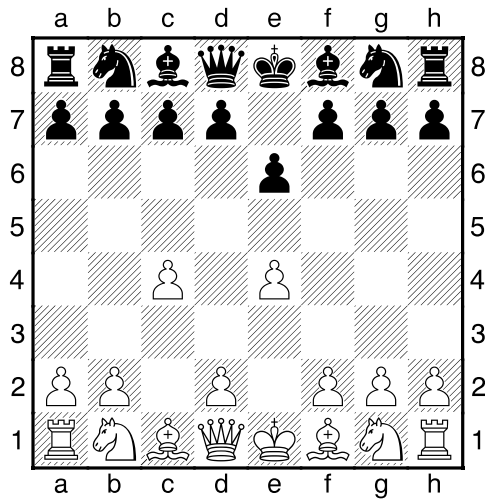

 28.Qxd2 Qxb3; 25.Qa6? Nd4!; 25.Qc4 Qxc4 26.bxc4 Rd3 27.Rc1.

25...h5! 26.Kg2 h4 27.f3 Rd3 28.Rc1 Rbd8 29.Nf1 hxg3 30.hxg3 Nh5 31.Bc5 Qg6
 32.Kf2 Rd1 33.Re1? A blunder. Better was 33.Rxd1 Rxd1 34.Rc2.

33...R8d2+! 34.Nxd2 Qxg3+ 35.Ke2 Qxe1+ 36.Kd3 Rxd2+ 0-1

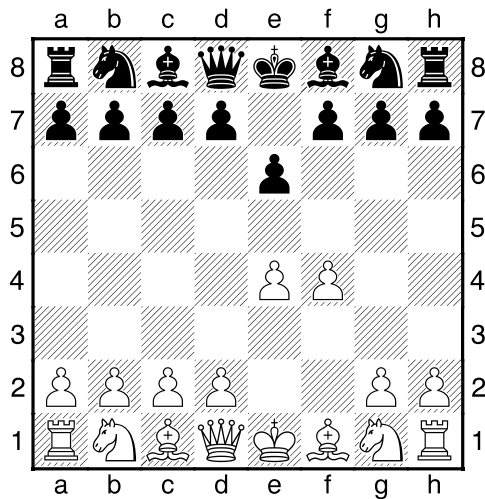
